MacArthur Green's website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

HOW DO WE USE COOKES?

We use cookies to enhance the online experience of our visitors, to allow us to better understand how our website is used and to monitor how advertisements perform. For example, cookies may tell us if you have visited our site before.

YOUR RIGHTS AND PREFERENCES

Cookies do not store financial information or information capable of identifying you. You have the right to choose whether you accept cookies. You can amend, set or block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our website.

TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

We use the following categories of cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies:** these are the cookies that are required for the operation of our website.
- Performance cookies: These allow us to recognise, analyse and count the number
 of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it.
 This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that
 users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies**: These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you.
- **Targeting cookies**: These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed.
